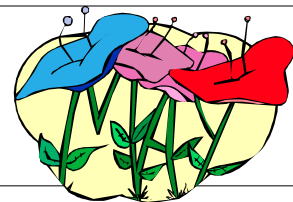

Remember that in order to operate these vehicles you require a valid driver's license and a helmet, as well as liability insurance. It is illegal for persons

under the age of 16 to be using these vehicles on streets, ditches, lanes or any public property. Remember not to drive your ATV anywhere you would not drive your other vehicles, such as the park, golf course or people's lawns. The RCMP are increasing enforcement in this matter, and the first responders do not want to have to respond to accidents involving these dangerous vehicles. Please drive these vehicles SAFELY!
